WELCOME BACK TO TERM 2

SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES

3. Students are expected to continue to bring their own personal thermometer for daily temperature taking. Staggered recesses and staggered dismissals will still be in place to minimise overcrowding, and students and staff will continue to practise wipe-down measures for their classroom and any special rooms that they need to utilise during the course of the day in school.
4. Please do not send your child to school if they are unwell or have flu-like symptoms. Do continue to speak to your child on the importance of social responsibility and adhering to the various Safe Management Measures.

52ND PRIZE-GIVING DAY

5. The school will be celebrating its 52nd Prize-Giving Day, with the theme “**Affirming Our Strengths, Celebrating Our Learning**” on Thursday 14 April 2022.

Our notable alumni, **Ms Natalie Henedige** and **Major Muhammad Iskandar**, will be gracing this occasion as our Guests of Honour as Broadricians past and present come together to celebrate our achievements and bear witness to how our school has progressed. Ms Natalie Henedige is the Festival Director of Singapore International Festival of Arts (2022 – 2024) and the Artistic Director of Cake, a contemporary performance company presenting progressive works at the intersection of theatre and a range of disciplines. Major Muhammad Iskandar is a fighter pilot with SAF with a



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Master's Degree in Public Policy from the University of Oxford, as a recipient of the SAF Overseas Masters Sponsorship and the University of Oxford Scholarship.

7. In view of SMM measures, all segments of this celebratory event will be recorded and shared via video with all students at their respective classrooms on 14 April 2022.

NATIONAL SCHOOLS GAMES (NSG)

8. With the announcement by The Multi-Ministry Task Force (MTF) on 11 March to allow 30 fully vaccinated persons to play together, The National School Games 2022 (NSG 2022) will resume in Term 2. All sports (with the exception of Rugby) will be played in their standard format. As we offer Basketball, Shooting, Taekwondo and Tchouckball as CCAs in Broadrick, students involved in these CCAs will be participating in the inter-school competitions following the required Safe Management Measures. 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Blended Learning (BL) Day

- Secondary One students will commence their Blended Learning (BL) in Term 2. As a recap, BL aims to nurture self-directed and independent learners who are passionate and intrinsically motivated.
- On BL days, students will be learning remotely from home. The allocated BL day is on **Tuesdays of the even week** timetable. For the Secondary Ones, they will report to school for the first BL lesson on 29 March 2022 to experience the flow of a simulated BL day. On this day, the IT department, Form Teachers and Subject Teachers will address issues students might face to ensure a smooth transition to subsequent BL days. The BL schedule for Term 2 is as follows:

UPDATES ON OUTDOOR CAMPS

Sec 1 Outdoor Adventure Camp (Non-Residential)

- The school will be organising our Annual Outdoor Adventure Camp for all Secondary One students at MOE Dairy Farm Outdoor Adventure Learning Centre from **Wed 18 May to Fri 20 May 2022** (Term 2 Week 9). The objective of this camp is to offer our students a variety of unique outdoor experiences that will inculcate the school values and achieve Character and Citizenship Education (CCE) Learning Outcomes.
- The camp will be **non-residential**, hence students will go home at the end of each day. Our students will experience a sense of adventure and independence while building teamwork and a stronger rapport with their peers and teachers. The programme for the camp is planned by MOE Outdoor Adventure Educators following Safe Management Measures.
- There will be a briefing conducted for the students and parents at a later date. Details for the briefing will be sent in a separate letter.



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Sec 3 MOE-OBS Challenge Programme (Non-Residential)

18. Our Secondary 3 students will be participating in the MOE-OBS Challenge Programme from **Thursday 27 Oct to Friday 28 Oct 2022**. This is part of the National Outdoor Adventure Education Master Plan which the Ministry of Education (MOE) has put in place to strengthen the holistic development of all our students. The programme seeks to develop ruggedness, resilience, and build cohesion amongst our youths.
19. The camp will be **non-residential**, hence students will go home at the end of each day. Our students will experience a sense of adventure and independence while building teamwork and a stronger rapport with their peers and teachers. Do note that all 'Height-element' related activities have been suspended and are therefore excluded from the camp programme.
20. There will be a briefing conducted for the students and parents at a later date. Do note that registration for the MOE OBS programme will be done online via FormSG. Details for the registration and the programme will be sent in a separate letter.
