Term 3 School Re-Opening Matters

8. With the nation's easing of SMM and transition to DORSCON Yellow, staggered dismissal will be removed with effect from Tuesday 5 July. Students will not be required to take their temperature daily. **A temperature taking exercise will take place on Wed 29 Jun**. However, wipe down routines and wearing of mask will continue to be practised. Should your child/ward be feeling unwell, do advise him/her to seek medical attention and refrain from coming to school until he/she is better. Students on other medication should have their prescribed medicine with them at all times as school will not be able to provide medication in any form to students.
9. With the general increase in the cost price of food supply, there will be a price adjustment to some of the food sold in our canteen. The price adjustment is in the range of 10 to 20 cents. We seek your understanding on this matter.
10. With the recent enhancement to Parents Gateway (PG), Broadrick will be adopting PG as the main channel of communication with parents/guardians and this includes communication by teachers with parents on various school activities and student related matters. We would like to appeal to parents to keep your communication with teachers during office hours to give them some time and space to attend to personal matters.
11. Do also note that some important announcements will be disseminated directly through PG, at the Ministry level. Hence, we appeal to parents/guardians who are not onboard PG to do so soonest possible. You can approach the form teachers for assistance.
