

9. The Singapore Youth Festival will resume in Term 2 for the following Performing Arts CCA:



### WEIGHTED ASSESSMENT 2 (WA2)

- 10. WA2 will be conducted between 04 May (Thursday) and 11 May 2023 (Thursday). The exact dates for each subject will be sent out closer to the assessment dates.
- 11. In 2022, MOE has announced the removal of mid-year examinations for all schools. One of the reasons for this change is for schools to provide a variety of learning experiences for our students and to also move away from an over-emphasis in academic grades.
- 12. Taking our cue from the NSG and the SYF which continues even through the assessment period, do note that CCA Activities will continue even during the WA2 period. However, to help our students ease into this new understanding, there will be a reduction in the intensity and frequency of CCA training over this period.



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### NATIONAL DIGITAL LITERACY PROGRAMME (NDLP) UPDATES

13. Our Secondary 1 students have just received their Personal Learning Devices (PLD) at the end of Term 1. This is a reminder that all students will be expected to bring their PLDs daily for lessons. In order to have a seamless learning experience, please ensure that your child's/ward's PLD is fully charged before they bring it to school. ### **Provision of Lockers for Students**


### UPDATES ON OUTDOOR CAMPS

### Sec 3 MOE-OBS Challenge Programme (Residential)

18. Our Secondary 3 students will be participating in the <u>MOE-OBS Challenge Residential</u> <u>Programme</u> from Tuesday 14 to Saturday 18 November 2023. This is part of the National Outdoor Adventure Education Master Plan which the Ministry of Education (MOE) has put in place to strengthen the holistic development of all our students. The programme seeks to develop ruggedness, resilience, and build cohesion amongst our youths.

As this is a National Programme being run for ALL Secondary 3 students in Singapore, Outward Bound Singapore (OBS) has planned for an early registration 6 months ahead of the date of the programme. Do note that e-registration for the MOE OBS programme will be done online via FormSG. The 3 week e-registration will commence from 22 May 2023.
- 20. The school will be conducting a briefing for the students and parents at a later date. Details for the briefing and registration will be sent in a separate letter prior to the above date.


