2022 GCE N Level Results

3. The 2022 GCE N Level Results was released on 19 December 2022 and it gives me great pleasure to share that our students have done well.

Normal (Technical) Stream:

- 100% qualify for ITE.
- 100% passes in Basic Tamil, and Art.
- Over 90% passes in Basic Malay, and Mathematics.

Normal (Academic) Stream:

- 11.3% qualify for the Poly Foundation Programme (PFP).
- 56.6% qualify for the Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP).
- 100% passes in English, Chinese, Malay, Science (Bio/Chem), and Art.
- Over 90% passes in Mathematics, Science (Phy/Chem), and Nutrition & Food Science.

Full Subject-Based Banding for Sec 1 and Sec 2s

4. We are now in our second year of implementing Full Subject-Based Banding (Full SBB). Our Sec 2 students as well as our new Sec 1 students will be grouped in mixed form classes, comprising students from all courses of study. Students will attend lessons with their form classes for the following subjects: Character and Citizenship Education, Music, Physical Education, Art, Design & Technology as well as Food and Consumer Education.

- 5. For other academic subjects, namely English, Mother Tongue Languages, Mathematics, Science, and the Humanities, students will be attending lessons based on their subject classes. These subject classes will be organised based on their respective course levels [N(T), N(A) or Express].
- 6. The common learning experience through the mixed form classes creates a valuable setting for students to mingle, build meaningful friendships, and appreciate different perspectives. With Full SBB, we are moving towards one secondary education, with many subject bands to better meet our students' learning needs. This is part of the broader shift in our education system to recognise the strengths and interests of our children, and to help them build their confidence and develop an intrinsic motivation to learn for life.


Continuation of Blended Learning Days

- 7. Blended Learning (BL) aims to nurture self-directed and independent learners who are passionate and intrinsically motivated. BL days comprise a mix of curriculum coverage and Student Initiated Learning (SIL) and will be conducted on Tuesdays on the following dates 10 Jan*, 7 Feb, 21 Feb, and 7 March for Term 1.
- 8. <u>For the first BL Day on 10 Jan</u>, Sec 2, 4 & 5 classes will learn from home, while the Sec 1 and 3 classes will report to school. <u>For following BL days</u>, Sec 1 students will continue to report to school on Blended Learning Days for lessons until they receive their learning devices.

- 9. All students are strongly encouraged to report to school by 7.20am before we commence with morning assembly at 7.30am.

Polytechnic Open House for Sec 4 and 5 (Express and Normal Academic)

- 11. Some of the Polytechnics will be holding their Open House from Thu 5 Jan to Sat 7 Jan 2023. There will be a variety of talks to engage students on the various courses in the polytechnics and students are encouraged to check their websites and attend these sessions.
- 12. Transport arrangements have been made for <u>all Sec 4/5 students (Exp and NA)</u> to attend one Open House of their choice on <u>Fri 6 Jan afternoon</u>. They will be dismissed at 12.30pm on that day and board the bus from 1pm onwards. A separate bus arrangement has been made for Muslim boys who are having Friday prayers. Students are expected to arrive back in school around 5.30pm, depending on the polytechnic they are visiting. More information will be provided to students on the first day of school.

Applied Learning Modules (ApLMs) for Sec 3 Express & Normal Academic

13. To support students as they explore their future career choices, Sec 3 Express and NA students can sign up for Applied Learning Modules conducted at the polytechnics. These electives will help students discover their strengths and interests by giving students the opportunity to apply their learning to authentic learning contexts and to make sense of how their knowledge can be translated into real world applications. The costs of the ApLMs are heavily subsidised and students only need to pay \$25 by cash or Edusave. More information will be provided by the ECG team when the school term starts.


Weighted Assessment 1 (WA1) and Weighted Assessment 2 (WA2)
