2024 Secondary 3 Normal (Technical) Subject Combination Selection Exercise

1. We would like to inform you that your child/ward will be participating in the Secondary 3 Subject Combination Selection Exercise from **Monday, 06 March 2023** to **Sunday, 12 March 2023**. This is an online exercise where all Secondary 2 students are to register their choices of subject combinations. Below are some important dates for you to take note:

Term 4 Week 6/7 20 Oct to 23 Oct	Subject Combination Registration II (for students who want to switch subject combination)
Term 4 Week 8 3 Nov	Confirmation of Subject Combination Results

2. To assist you and your child/ward in his/her selection, kindly refer to **Annex A** for more information and additionally, do discuss and consider the following factors:
 - your child's/ward's interests, strengths and career options,
 - his/her ability to cope with the subject combination chosen, and
 - requirements/criteria for courses at post-secondary institutions (available in the Student Handbook).
3. We also wish to inform you that the offer of subject combination to students will be based on:
 - student's academic performance at Secondary 2,
 - specific subject criteria, and
 - demand for the subject.
4. Please note that the school reserves the right **not to offer** combinations/subjects which do not have at least 15 students who qualify and opt to take the subject.
5. We aim to give the students their first choice. The students will remain in the allocated subject combination if they are able to meet the subject criteria by the end of the year. Otherwise, an alternate subject combination based on student's choice, subject criteria and availability of the subject combination group, will be allocated.
6. Each student will submit their subject combination choices, in order of preference.
