- 7. This is further subjected to the following conditions:
 - They are limited to a maximum of 3 cross-stream subjects.
 - They are required to be performing well in other core subjects (e.g. at least a pass in English).
 - They are expected to bridge the content gap on their own. No structured bridging programme will be provided by the school.
- 8. Should your child/ward qualify for cross-stream subjects, he/she will be informed at the end of the year.
