Important Updates & Reminders for Secondary 3 Adventure Camp

3. **Reporting Time:** Students are expected to report to school as usual on **Monday, 15 Jan 2018** by **7.20am** for silent reading before morning assembly commences at 7.30am. After assembly, students will gather for a morning camp briefing before they head off together to Pulau Ubin.

4. **Student Safety during Camp Activities:** All camp activities should be within the students' comfort zone. Students who are uncomfortable about any activity may opt not to participate.
5. **Dismissal Time:** Students will be dismissed from school by **3pm** on **Wednesday, 17 Jan 2018**. **All students are expected to report back to school on Thursday, 18 Jan 2018 for regular lessons.**
6. **VIA Component:** As the original vendor has been unable to meet the school's needs and optimise students' learning, we have decided to postpone this VIA component. **On 18 January, normal lessons will resume according to the time-table instead.** The school will continue to use Character and Citizenship Education (CCE) lessons to engage students in VIA and service-learning.
7. **Contacting your child:** Should you urgently need to contact your child during school operating hours, you can reach the school General Office at **63445025**. 8. **Pick-Up Procedures:** Should you need to pick up your child before the camp is officially dismissed (eg. due to medical reasons), we will arrange for you to pick up your child at Changi Point Ferry Terminal. A teacher will accompany your child to Changi Point Ferry Terminal to await your pick-up.
9. **Students who are not attending camp** are required to report to school daily at the usual reporting time.
